


We are dedicated to providing their children with quality education and nourishing their value system. We would not be able to do this without their cooperation.

- 7. Management and Leadership team who own a vision and track the metrics of growth






Orientation for Parents

The orientation programme was to familiarize the parents with the curriculum, rules and regulations of the school, teaching methodologies, and the co-scholastic activities.



Commencement of KGI and KGII








All the activities were carried out in a planned manner and the tiny tots took back home an attractive headgear.

Students participated in various painting activities related to World Earth Day. Every day is going to be Earth Day for them, as they will water the plants and see them grow daily.






It was hands-on experience for the little ones.

Parent - Teacher Conference

A Parent–Teacher Conference is a short meeting or conference between the parents and teachers of students to discuss a child's progress at school and find solutions to academic or behavioral problems.

PTC checklists for Parents:

Before the Conference —

- Ask your child how he/she feels about school.
- Ask your child if there is anything that he/she wants you to talk about with his/her teacher.
- Tell your child that you and the teacher are meeting to help him/her.
- Make a list of topics that you want to talk about with the teacher.
- Prepare a list of questions such as:
 - o What are my child's strongest and weakest subjects?
 - o Does my child hand homework in on time?
 - Does my child participate in class?
 - o Does my child seem happy at school?
 - O What can I do at home to help?

During the Conference —

- Be on time (or early) for the meeting.
- End the meeting on time. Other parents will probably have a meeting after yours.
- Relax and be yourself.
- Stay calm during the meeting.
- Ask the most important questions first.
- If your child receives special services such as English classes, ask about your child's progress in those classes.
- Ask for explanations of anything that you don't understand.
- Ask your child's teacher for ways that you can help your child at home.
- Thank the teacher.

After the Conference --

- Talk about the meeting with your child.
- Talk about the positive points, and be direct about the problems.
- Tell your child about any plans that you and the teacher created.
- Keep in touch with the teacher during the academic year.




The day ended with all mothers and children, enjoying the moments and taking back fond memories of a day well spent.












Kindergarten children joined the session wearing a magical hat / cap or a coloured dress with numbers pinned or stapled on it.

Kids at Lovedale International Kindergarten did activities related to **World Environment Day** by doing handprint activity, sang songs, and they also watched videos related to the theme.






Parent - Teacher Conference

It has helped when parents grasp the school curriculum and understanding the teacher's style of education. Here are some questions for them to ask during the Parent-Teacher Conference:

- 1. Is my child keeping up with the school's curriculum?
- 2. What is the school's approach to homework? How are they reflecting on my child's progress?
- 3. What can we do to help you out and work together to help my child grow this year?
- 4. What is your preferred teaching style? What methods can be implemented at home to be consistent with that of yours?
- 5. How can we get in touch with you?
- 6. Can you recommend some activities to support and polish my child's learning?
- 7. What is the standard of studies at which our child should be performing?
- 8. Can you discuss the areas in which my child is falling short?
- 9. Which subjects are the most challenging for my child?
- 10. Is my child facing difficulties on just tests or with schoolwork in general?
- 11. Have you noticed if my child is more responsive to a specific type of teaching? Can you suggest what we could do to improve the areas where my child is lacking?
- 12. What support structure is given to help my child keep up with their classmates?
- 13. Are there any challenges you're facing with teaching my child? How can we overcome those together?
- 14. How is my child's academic performance in comparison with his classmates?
- 15. Does the teacher think that my child is having trouble socializing?
- 16. What can we do to help my child make friends and interact more productively?


